

Luang Prabang (Laos) 3 Days / 2 Nights Land Tours

Luang Prabang is a beautiful and tranquil dream-like setting with a fusion of foreign influences and splendid landscape scenery, making this an idyllic, unspoiled and charming destination for visitors. It is no wonder this amazing city was recently declared a World Heritage City by UNESCO. The ancient city was the former capital of Laos, with a reign of more than 63 kings over 600 years. Luang Prabang is known as the 'Thousand Pagoda City', there are countless intriguing architectural highlights in the sleepy and once royal capital.

Day 1: Arrival Luang Prabang

As you will arrive in our heritage town, you will be picked up and transferred to your centrally-located hotel. After a short rest, we will start the visit of the National Museum, which presents various leaders and fighters of Laos history, from the ancient times till the new revolution period. Following the Museum, we will enjoy a sightseeing tour of two magnificent temples: the Wat Visoun and Wat Xienthong - which is the City's oldest temple, one of the best examples of Luang Prabang's classical architecture. We will then climb up the Phousi Mountain to enjoy its sacred stupa as well as a beautiful sunset view of the city and the river. From there, we will explore the Night Market Street, where you'll be able to find lovely handicrafts made by our local people. O/N in Luang Prabang.

Day 2: Luang Prabang – Pak Ou Cave-Kuang Si Waterfall (B, L, D)

After breakfast we will take a boat to the mysterious Pak Ou Cave and its thousand Buddha statues of various shapes and sizes. Along the way, we will stop at Ban Xanghai, the well-known village for Lao traditional rice whisky to be distilled and tasted. After the Cave we will have lunch in one of Luang Prabang's favourite restaurants, followed by a long drive to the Kuang Si Waterfall with its green surroundings as the preserved National Nature. En route, stop to visit Ban Na Oune, a small Hmong village and also visit Ban Tha Pane, a small village of Khmu minority group. Return to Luang Prabang by late afternoon and stop at Ban Xangkhong, a weavers village. We will end our day observing Buddha's footprints at Wat Siphouthabath. O/N in Luang Prabang

Day 3: Luang Prabang - Departure (B)

Early morning see a procession of monks. We will then head to the Morning market, the best place to buy presents for your friends and relatives. After breakfast, you will have free time for your own exploration of the town before your transfer to the airport.
